KeyStage 2 - Year 6

- In 2017, the percentage of pupils who achieved the expected standard in Reading, Writing and Maths in KS2 combined was **65 % (4 % above national average)**.
- Average scaled scores in tests in 2017 were :
 - Reading Average scaled score: 103 (National 104);
 - Maths Average scaled score: 109 (National 104)
 - GPS Average scaled score: 106 (National 105)



- The percentage of pupils attaining higher levels were
 - 23% Reading,
 - 16% writing,
 - 23 % maths
 - 26% GPS
