### A reminder re Covid Restrictions:

I'm truly hopeful that we can get through the final week of term without a Covid related bubble closure – the local numbers of self-isolation and positive cases is high. Lots of other schools have had full or partial closure this week or over recent weeks. We have had several families and some staff in isolation at points this week, with many returning straight away when they have been given the all clear. Let's all do all we can to keep safe!

As a result, WE WILL NOT BE CHANGING ANY COVID RELATED PROCEDURES until September 2021. That means we will be continuing to wear face masks, maintain one way systems, having limited access to parents into school (e.g. one at a time in main entrance and no parents into classrooms) until the end of term. Any changes we choose to make will not come into effect until September and will be carefully risk-assessed and communicated to you before the start of the new school year.

I want to keep our children, staff team, families and communities as safe as possible. We will do all we can to ensure we avoid bubble closures before the end of term.
