Since my letter on Tuesday, as you may well have seen/heard in the news, the following advice/guidance is now in place:

Confirmatory PCR tests to be temporarily suspended for positive lateral flow device (LFD) test results Confirmatory PCR tests following a positive lateral flow device (LFD) test result are to be temporarily suspended from Tuesday 11 January. This will mean that anyone who receives a positive LFD test result will be required to self-isolate immediately and will not be required to take a confirmatory PCR test.

We will continue to do our absolute best, with the care of the children at the forefront of what we do.
