Important information - Safety of the School and wider community

A number of parents are now using the carpark when they are not permitted to do so, which is causing potential risk for the children. Please do not use the staff car park unless you are allowed to do so. I will be addressing the issue with people failing to comply with a simple and polite safety request.
