

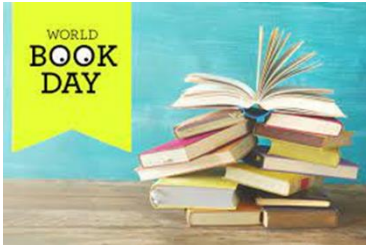

- Rev Becky – Reverend Becky led Monday's whole school assembly and talked about Lent. She also shared lots of great information about 'toilet Twinning' and the fundraising they will doing to help support families in less advantaged countries have access to clean water and a toilet!.
