Other news & Reminders:

- Young Voices. 19 children from school are taking part in the Young Voices Event on Friday 22nd April 2022 . For those taking part please do refer to the parent mails/letters you have received for further details.



- Year 6 Leaver Hoodies: Parents of children in Year 6 please do read and follow up on the parent mail about ordering your Leavers Hoodie.
- Over the Easter break we are having further re-decoration of school – this time the classrooms for our older children are being painted and having some refurbishment. Pyrenees class and Rocky class will have freshly painted rooms and new display boards for their post Easter return.
- Clubs: The only club that is running the first week of the summer term is Doncaster Rovers After School club (Monday afternoons)
- We have a training day on Friday 27th May 2022 – therefore children finish for May Half term at the end of day on Thursday 26th May 2022 and return to school on 6th June.
- Reminder re School Drop off- Only year 5 and 6 children, with signed permission, should be on school site by themselves – all other children should be accompanied by an adult or older sibling if appropriate.
- A reminder that all children are expected to have high standard of uniform and PE Kits please.
- Assessment: In May Year 6 pupils (from Rocky class) take their Key Stage 2 National Curriculum tests or SATs (week beginning 9th May) . In addition, Year 2 children (Andes class) will be completing their end of Key Stage 1 assessments the following week (Monday 16th May). Both of these sets of standardised tests are compulsory and taken by all pupils across the country. It is really important that both Year 2 and Year 6 pupils have excellent attendance over the next few weeks either side of the Easter break.
