Ocean e.g. Arctic, Southern, Atlantic, Pacific, Indian	A very large expanse of sea. There are 5 oceans of the world.	Continent e.g. Asia, Africa, North America, South America, Antarctica, Europe, Australasia/Oceania	A large landmass made up of different countries. There are 7 continents of the world.
Map	A map is a drawing of all or part of the Earth's surface. Its basic purpose is to show where things are. An atlas is a book of maps.	UK (United Kingdom) E.g. England, Scotland, Wales, Northern Ireland	We live in the UK, it is in the continent of Europe. The capital cities of the UK are London, Edinburgh, Cardiff, Belfast.
Island	A piece of land surrounded by water	Equator	An imaginary circle around the middle of the earth.
Globe	A sphere on which there is a map of the world.	Climate	The usual weather in an area The UK has a temperate climate. This means it gets cool, wet winters and warm, wet summers.
