- When the earth is facing the sun it is day.
- When the earth is facing away from the sun it is night.
- It takes 1 year for the earth to move around the sun.
- During the Spring and Summer months, the days get longer and the nights get shorter.
- During the Autumn and Winter months, the days get shorter and the nights get longer.
