•	Using dots of varying size is called stippling							
•	Changing the size of the dots will create tone							
•	The larger the dot the lighter the tone, the smaller the dot the darker the tone							
•	Shading can be used to remove an outline around a focal point							
•	Modelled grids can be used to transfer an image
