- 1. French does not use capital letters for the months or days.
- 2. Numbers with a final digit of 1, e.g. 21, 31, 41 etc are written **vingt et un** (twenty <u>and one</u>). All other numbers are as they sound e.g. 34 **trente-quatre**.
- 3. Don't forget the hyphen between the numbers: vingt-trois
- 4. When you say the full date in French (with the day of the week) you don't say 'the' (le)
- 5. The first day of the month is different: **Cést le premier**
- 6. They don't send Christmas cards in France—they send New Year cards instead.
