<ol style="list-style-type: none"> French does not use capital letters for the months or days. Numbers with a final digit of 1, e.g. 21, 31, 41 etc are written vingt et un (twenty <u>and</u> one). All other numbers are as they sound e.g. 34 trente-quatre. Don't forget the hyphen between the numbers: vingt-trois When you say the full date in French (with the day of the week) you don't say 'the' (le) The first day of the month is different: C'est le premier
