Key Knowledge

- 1. In French, most adjectives go after the noun e.g **un nez** <u>rouge</u> (except **petit** and **grand** they come BEFORE the noun).
- 2. Remember to add a silent **s** at the end of simple plurals
- 3. In French, one eye is **un oeil** but **les yeux** is the plural form. **Genou/genoux** is another exception. **Nez** does not change at all.
- 4. Sometimes English uses one word for a noun e.g freckles, but French uses three e.g taches de rousseur .
