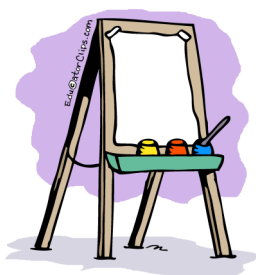

Key Knowledge	
1.	In French, most adjectives go after the noun e.g un nez rouge (except petit and grand - they come BEFORE the noun).
2.	Remember to add a silent s at the end of simple plurals
3.	In French, one eye is un oeil but les yeux is the plural form. Genou/genoux is another exception. Nez does not change at all.
4.	Sometimes English uses one word for a noun e.g freckles, but French uses three e.g taches de rousseur .
