<b>c'est fantastique</b>	It's fantastic	<b>il aime/elle aime</b>	he likes/she likes

Key Knowledge	
1.	When buying items which in English you could take 'some of', you say: <b>du</b> for masculine nouns, <b>de la</b> for feminine nouns and <b>des</b> for plural nouns e.g. <b>du parfum</b> , <b>des chaussettes</b> .
2.	Colour adjectives follow the noun, Adjectives such as <b>joli</b> , <b>petit</b> , <b>grand</b> go before the noun.
3.	The word 'my' in French changes according to gender: <b>mon</b> + masculine, <b>ma</b> + feminine, <b>mes</b> + plural.
4.	The <b>x</b> on <b>prix</b> is silent.
