Key Knowledge

 When buying items which in English you could take 'some of', you say: du for masculine nouns, de la for feminine nouns and des for plural nouns e.g. <u>du</u> parfum, des chaussettes.

- 2. Colour adjectives follow the noun, Adjectives such as **joli, petit, grand** go before the noun.
- The word 'my' in French changes according to gender: mon + masculine, ma + feminine, mes
 + plural.
- 4. The **x** on **prix** is silent.
