Key Knowledge	
1.	When buying items which in English you could take 'some of', you say: du for masculine nouns, de la for feminine nouns and des for plural nouns e.g. du parfum , des chaussettes .
2.	Colour adjectives follow the noun, Adjectives such as joli , petit , grand go before the noun.
3.	The word 'my' in French changes according to gender: mon + masculine, ma + feminine, mes + plural.
4.	The x on prix is silent.
