<p>Jewish (recap Y1)</p>  <p>Star of David</p>	<p>Jews follow a religion called Judaism</p> <p>The Star of David is a Jewish symbol</p> <p>Jewish people believe in one God</p>	<p>Shabbat</p> <p>Synagogue (recap Y1)</p>	<p>Also known as Sabbath, is an old Jewish celebration. It falls every Friday evening and lasts until nightfall the following day.</p> <p>There is a Shabbat meal. It is a day of rest.</p> <p>Jewish people visit the Synagogue during Shabbat</p> <p>A synagogue, sometimes called a temple is a Jewish place of worship.</p>
<p>Mezuzah scroll</p> <p>Hebrew</p>	<p>It is a Hebrew word which means doorpost.</p> <p>The mezuzah is small scroll fixed to the doorpost</p> <p>This is a language from Israel. Many Jewish things come from the Hebrew language</p>	<p>Torah scroll</p>  <p>Scrolls</p> <p>sacred (recap from Y1)</p>	<p>The Jewish holy book is called the Torah or Torah scroll</p> <p>It is a sacred long scroll in Hebrew.</p> <p>Scrolls are paper (rolled up)</p> <p>Sacred means considered to be holy and deserving respect, especially because of a connection with a god</p>
<p>Hanukkah (Chanukah) miracle</p>	<p>This is a Jewish festival of light</p> <p>A miracle is an amazing event that cannot be explained so it is believed to be linked to God.</p>	<p>Menorah</p> 	<p>The menorah is a lamp used to celebrate, remember and honour the miracle of Hanukkah</p>
