<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hatching can be used over the top of colour to add detail • Increasing the density of hatching creates tone • The closer the lines are the darker the tone, the further apart the lines are, the lighter the tone • Blending the pressure of your pencil gives a smooth continuum throughout an illustration
