Key Information

- Hatching can be used over the top of colour to add detail
- Increasing the density of hatching creates tone
- The closer the lines are the darker the tone, the further apart the lines are, the lighter the tone
- Blending the pressure of your pencil gives a smooth continuum throughout an illustration
