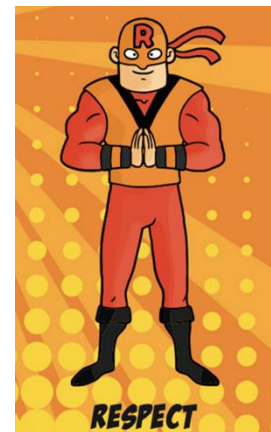
Discrimination and Protected Characteristics

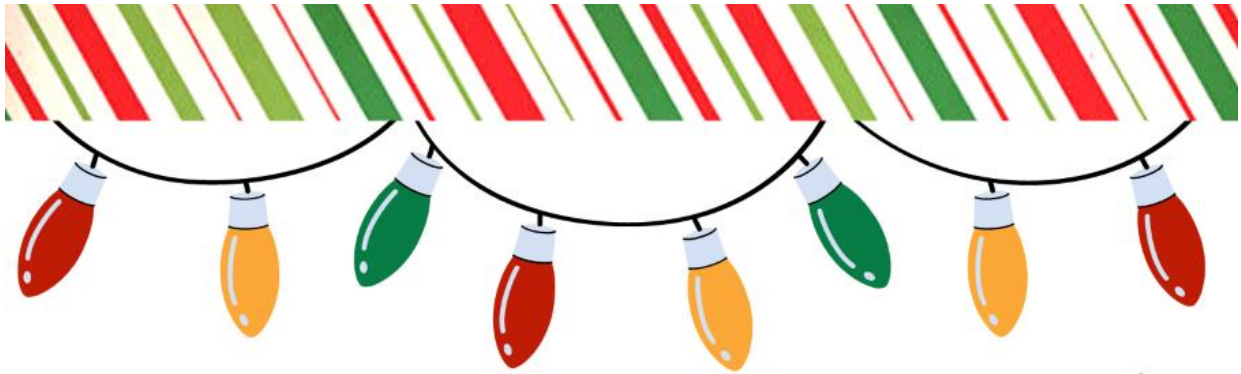
