

City	Cities are the largest kind of settlements and often have millions of people living in them.  York, Leeds, Hull, Doncaster, London	Map	A map is a drawing of all or part of Earth's surface. Its used to show where things are.
Village	Villages are small settlements with a small number of houses for a few hundred people.  Carlton, Camblesforth, Drax	Key  symbol	This explains the symbols on a map  A thing that represent something else
Town	A town is a larger settlement than a village. More people live in a town – normally a couple of thousand - so they need more homes and more shops. Selby, Goole	Ordnance Survey map	An Ordnance Survey map is de-tailed map produced by the government.
