Key Knowledge

- In French, nouns are either masculine (**un**) or feminine (**une**).
 - Hamster has a silent 'h' and sounds like 'amstaire'.
 - ch sounds like sh.
 - There are several ways to ask the question 'Have you got a pet?'
- Tu as un animal?**
 - As-tu un animal?**
 - Est-ce que tu as un animal?**
- When making an animal plural, most of the time you can just add an s, with the exception of animals (animaux), chevaux (horses), oiseaux (birds) and souris (mice—no change!)
