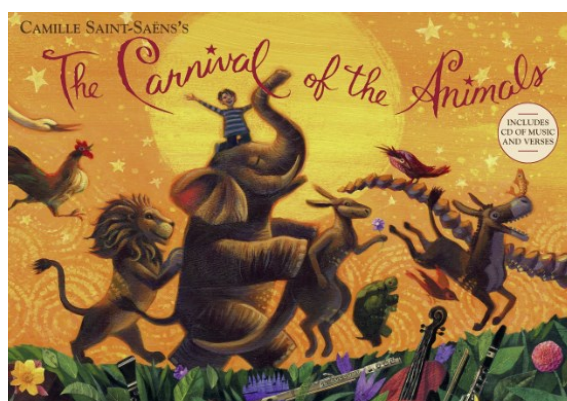

<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Camille Saint-Saens (1835-1921) was a French composer. He wrote lots of music. Camille was very fond of animals and loved to watch them. He listened carefully to the sounds they made. He noticed exactly how they moved. 2. Animal sounds are represented differently in French e.g. 'moo' is 'meuh'. 3. D'accord ends with a d but it is silent. 4. Days and months do not have capital letters in French (though you will see them with capital letters in signs, posters etc).
