<p>1. To achieve a good French accent:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • use short vowel sounds • Don't pronounce the h at the start of a word • Consonants at the end of a word are silent <p>2. When in conversation, hesitation, gestures, apologising and asking (in French) for repetition are helpful strategies.</p>
