•	Holi is also known as the "festival of colours".					
•	Holi marks the arrival of spring and the end of winter. It is usually celebrated in March					
•	Holi also celebrates the Hindu god Krishna and the legend of Holika and Prahlad					
•	Hola Mohalla takes place the day after Holi and lasts for 3 days					
•	People hold mock battles during Hola Mohalla to remember the importance of being brave and being ready					
•	Hola means the charge of an army, Mohalla means an organised procession
