 <p>Florence Nightingale lived from 1820 to 1910</p> <p>Florence Nightingale became a nurse. She helped the soldiers and the other nurses in the hospitals in the Crimean War. She set up a nursing school to help train nurses and improve the job all nurses did.</p> <p>Florence's achievements were she introduced modern nursing, helped reduce the deaths of soldiers and found a nursing school.</p>	 <p>Mary Seacole lived from 1805 to 1881</p> <p>Mary Seacole became a nurse. She was a woman of colour but she was not taken on as a hospital nurse so she went out to the Crimean war on her own so that she could help the soldiers. She set up a hotel where the soldiers could stay and eat and even helped the soldiers on the battlefield.</p> <p>Mary's achievements were, when many people of colour were still slaves, she helped the sick and wounded in the Caribbean and in Crimea</p>
