Welcome as ever to our weekly newsletter. A slightly shorter newsletter this week

This week:

- Thank you for your understanding with regards to our school closure this week , as a result of the NEU industrial action on Wednesday 5th and Friday 7th July.
- Our Year 6 children who are moving to Carlton Holy Family Catholic High School in September had a successful transition day on Tuesday.
- Pumas and Tigers summer production: Our show rehearsals are progressing well, although it had been a real challenge to have everyone together, with Y6 transition days at Snaith last week, Holy Family this week and Brayton next week. Add in the enforced closure for strike days and it has really limited the amount of time the whole cast can be together. The children are performing to the school on Wednesday afternoon and to parents and family member on Wednesday evening. All children from Pumas and Tigers have had a letter sent about ticket arrangements.
- The Teaching Assistants, Office staff, caretaker and I had an action packed and physical day on Wednesday, seizing the opportunity of school closure to make the necessary changes in school for our 7th classroom. All of the books from the Grey Temporary Classroom Unit (TCU)/ library & community hub, were moved into the brown TCU/Carlton Owls – this building will host both Owls and library in September 2023. The grey TCU will become our 7th classroom in September, with Mrs Short's and Mrs Reading's Year 4 Pine class being based there. Tables, chairs and resources have been moved in as we start to prepare for the year ahead.
- Ongoing improvements in school: I am pleased to report that on Wednesday we replaced the carpet in our Leopards /Year 2 classroom and on today our Pumas/Year4&5 classroom will also have the carpet replaced. This is part of rolling investment and improvement to our premises

<u>Carlton Owls.</u> Our Carlton owls wrap around care facility has been successfully running for a number of years now. In this time, we have not previously increased our pricing. Unfortunately, due to the increases of costs for food, utilities and staffing we have decided that we have to increase the charge per session for September 2023.

From September 2023, after school provision will now be charged at £9 per session. This will continue to run from 3.15pm to 5.30pm. Because of the change of day timings in September , breakfast club will be a little shorter in length. As a result, we are not increasing this and it will remain as £4 per morning session. The breakfast sessions are available from 7.30 am onwards.
