Key Knowledge

- Prehistory is the time before written records began, we know about this time period from sources of evidence left behind.
- During this time there were different ages Stone Age, Bronze Age and Iron Age.
- People migrated to Britain during the Stone Age and survived as huntergatherers.
- As tools became more advanced and settlements appeared, the use of metals meant the Stone Age became the Bronze Age and eventually, the Iron Age.
