#### Planning ahead:

**Year 6 parents** -it is already that time of year when you need to be selecting the secondary/high school for your child for September 2024. This is obviously an important decision for both you and your child. In order to secure your first choice, all application must be made by <u>31<sup>st</sup> October 2023</u>. We will share all information we receive from all local schools. Please refer to Parent Mail from earlier this week re application processes for NYC schools and for more information.

Applications must be made by 15<sup>th</sup> January 2024, so we have made several available dates when prospective parents can visit our school – please see attached flyer and diary dates later in this newsletter.
