<p><b>Key Knowledge</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The weather changes with the seasons.</li> <li>• There are different types of weather including; sunny, rainy, windy, cloudy, snowy, thunder and lightning, rainbow.</li> <li>• When the earth is facing the sun it is day.</li> <li>• When the earth is facing away from the sun it is night.</li> <li>• It takes 1 year for the earth to move around the sun.</li> <li>• During the Spring and Summer months, the days get longer and the nights get shorter.</li> <li>• During the Autumn and Winter months, the days get shorter and the nights get longer.</li> </ul>
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
