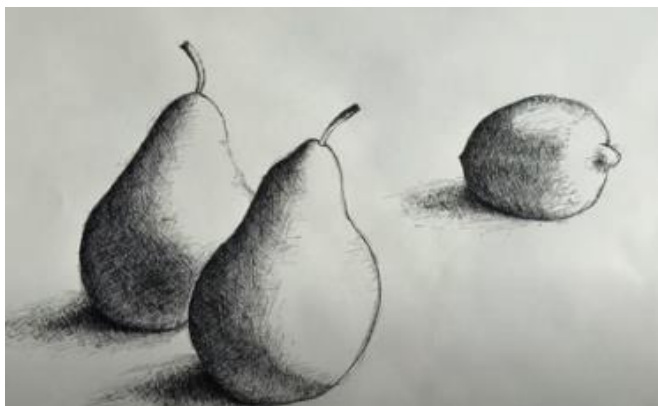

Key Knowledge



Chiaroscuro is a technique used by artists to create depth in their work by using light and dark.

Where light is reflecting on an object, in order to show this, no cross hatching can be used and when there is a shadow, dense cross hatching can be used to create a 3D effect.

Still life is the art of drawing or painting inanimate objects such as fruit, flowers and household items.
