## Key Knowledge

- When buying items, which in English you could take 'some' of, in French you say: **du** for masculine nouns, **de la** for feminine nouns and **des** for plural nouns.
- Colour adjectives, like most adjectives, follow the noun, other adjectives such as joli, petit, grand are exceptions and precede the noun.
- The word "my" in French changes according to gender: mon + masculine, ma + feminine and mes + plural.
- NOTE: if the word following my is feminine but starts with a vowel you need to use 'mon' so that it sounds right:

e.g. amie is feminine, it should be ma amie but doesn't sound right so it is mon amie.
