<p>Key Knowledge</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> When buying items, which in English you could take 'some' of, in French you say: du for masculine nouns, de la for feminine nouns and des for plural nouns. Colour adjectives, like most adjectives, follow the noun, other adjectives such as joli, petit, grand are exceptions and precede the noun. The word "my" in French changes according to gender: mon + masculine, ma + feminine and mes + plural. NOTE: if the word following my is feminine but starts with a vowel you need to use 'mon' so that it sounds right: e.g. amie is feminine, it should be ma amie but doesn't sound right so it is mon amie.
