

- In China along the yellow river
- It happened during the same time as the Bronze Age in Britain
- Capital was Yin
- King Tang first king.
- King Di Xin last king.
- Battle of Muye ended the Shang Dynasty when Di Xin's troops betrayed him and he covered himself in jewels and set his house on fire with himself inside
- Bronze was used a lot during this period to make religious and special objects
- Social class was important during the Shang Dynasty and royalty and priests were at the top and farmers and prisoners were at the bottom of the social ladder
