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Hello and welcome to our final newsletter of this second term. The weeks and months are flying by! As always at the end of term we have had a particular busy and 'eggciting' time in school.

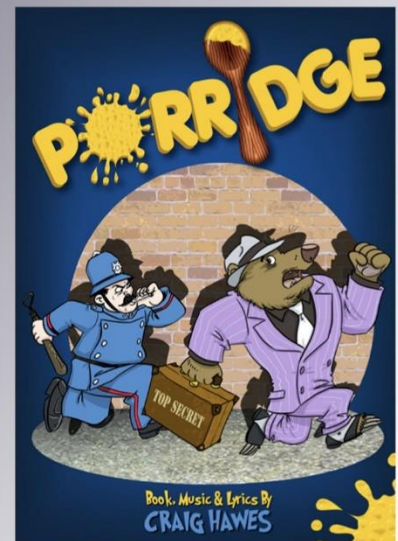
