

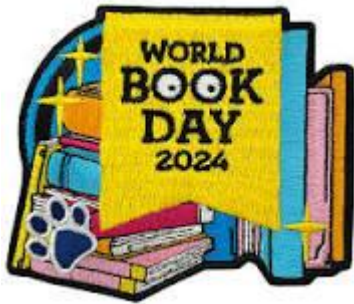

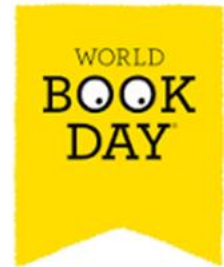
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Welcome, as ever to our weekly newsletter. What a fabulous week it has been here at Carlton Primary School.

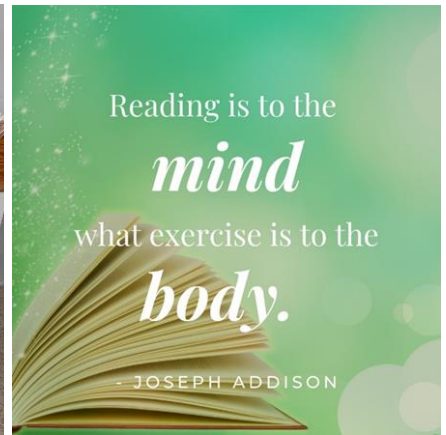




World Book Day Raffle:
