In addition, Year 2 children (Hawthorn class) will be completing their end of Key Stage 1 assessments the following week (Monday 20<sup>th</sup> May). It is really important that both Year 2 and particularly Year 6 pupils have excellent attendance over the next few weeks.
- School Drop off- Only year 5 and 6 children, with signed permission, should be on school site by themselves – all other children should be accompanied by an adult or older sibling if appropriate.
