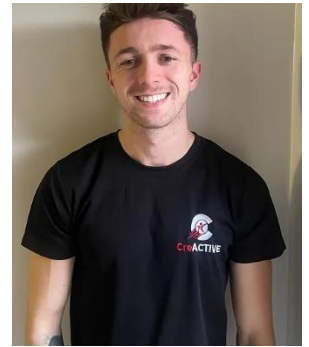

- Tommy and Georgia for their gold and silver medals from a recent Taekwondo tournament.

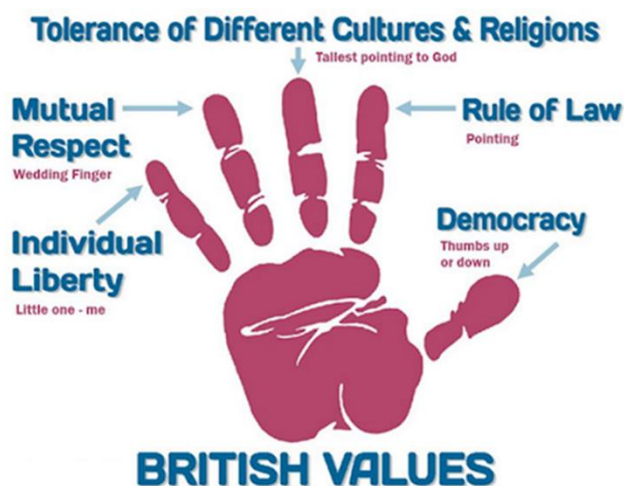


Good to Be Gold Celebration event:
