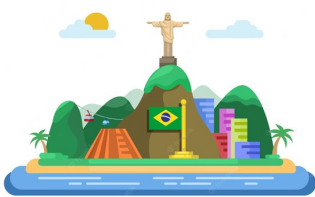

<b>vegetation</b>	plants found in a particular area or habitat	<b>rainforest</b>	a forest typically found in tropical areas with heavy rainfall
<b>climate (recap)</b>	the main weather conditions in an area	<b>equator</b>	an imaginary line or circle around the middle of the earth to divide the North and South Hemispheres
<b>tropical</b>	hot usually wet climates		
<b>temperate (recap)</b>	climates that are not too hot or too cold		

<p><b>Key Knowledge</b></p> <p>The UK is in Europe. The UK's climate is temperate. This means it gets cool winters and warm summers.</p> <p>Brazil is in South America. The capital city is Brasilia. Brazil's climate is tropical. This means it is hot, usually wet and humid.</p> <p>The Amazon is the world's largest tropical rainforest. The Amazon is found in South America, spanning across Brazil, Bolivia, Peru, Ecuador, Colombia, Venezuela, Guyana, Suriname and French Guiana.</p> <p>Brazilians speak Portuguese. The population is 216 million compared with the UK's 68 million. Brazil is the 5th largest country by area and 6th biggest country by population. The most famous landmark of Brazil is located in Rio de Janeiro. The Christ the Redeemer statue overlooks the city and Sugarloaf mountain</p>
