Key Knowledge

Countries that end in "e" are feminine - Eg; La France, L'Allemagne - all other countries are masculine.

England: L'Angleterre = land of the Angles.

If they want to say 'of France', it is de la France but 'of Portugal' is du Portugal as Portugal is masculine.

Languages around the world have come from different origins and the main languages spoken across Europe are referred to as Indo-European. These are split into

Nationalities begin with lower case letters when used as an adjective, accompanied

by a noun e.g. Je suis un garçon italien.

When nationality is used on its own (as a proper noun) it takes a capital letter e.g.

Je súis Italien. (male) Je suis Italien<u>ne</u>. (female) - Literally 'I am an Italian person.'
