Key Knowledge

- When learning new vocabulary it is helpful to think about counting syllables when saying and repeating the word. We could say and action beat the word 'batt-er-ie' when thinking about the word 'drum'. This has 3 syllables.
- The main musical activities taught in French schools are singing and listening to music. Teachers study around 10 songs with their class and they focus on vocal training, rhythmic and melodic accuracy, breathing and articulation.
- The question stem 'Qui?' meaning 'who?' is pronounced with a 'K' sound. So 'qui' sounds like 'key'.
