Welcome to our second newsletter of the new school year.

This week: our first two weeks back have been very successful. I am really proud of all of our pupils and of the staff team for the way they have collectively approached this new school year. Classrooms have been consistently purposeful and productive. The children are settling (back) into new routines well and the atmosphere has been so calm and positive. The standards of good behaviour have also been pleasing.



Other news in school:

- On Wednesday we welcomed our new Mrs (S) Smith, our new music instructor into school – she had her first lessons with Year 1 and Year 5, as well as meeting everyone in our singing assemblies. Welcome Mrs Smith! (FYI : We now have two Mrs Smiths!)
- Alnwick Class: This week Mrs (K) Smith, Mrs Bramley and Mrs Chiverton have had all of the new Reception intake in for full days and for the whole week. Well done to all of Alnwick class for a super week
- Pupils numbers: New families: our newest members of Carlton Primary school are really settling into their classes and the school as whole. A good start folks! Well done. For your information we now have 175 children in school.
- Young Voices 2025 - On Thursday all parents of Year4,5 and 6 children received a letter about Young Voices. The concert will take place on **Thursday 9th January** at Sheffield Arena with thousands of children coming together to sing as one choir. In preparation for the concert we will be starting our Young Voices after school choir club on Monday 16th September, which will then run every Monday from 3:15pm-4pm until the concert date. I love this event and fully recommend it to all of our pupils
- School Council elections – children in Y2-Y6 have been or will be voting for their school council representatives.

- Robinwood Residential trip: I spoke to the children of Warwick (Year 5) and Windsor (Year 6) this week about the brilliant trip we have booked for early December. I encouraged everyone to participate – even if they are a little worried or nervous. If anyone needs any further information about this trip and is still undecided please do talk to me! It such a rich and valuable experience that we ideally want all of our pupils to have.

September 2025! Important information:

I can't quite believe it already time for us to start talking about next academic year – this has particular importance for our new/current **Year 6 children in Windsor class**.

Year 6 parents should have received a letter earlier in the week explaining the application process for secondary school places. Over the next few weeks all local schools are holding their open day events for the Year 6 children to attend. We recommended you go and see as many schools as you can to help you make an informed choice. For your information our children move typically either to the Snaith School, Carlton Holy Family Catholic High School or Brayton Academy.

The deadline for Year 6 applications to be received is 31st October 2024.

We will share all information we receive from all local schools. Please refer to Parent Mail from earlier this week re application processes for NYC schools and for more information.

It is also that time of year when we already have to start thinking about our own **Reception intake for September 2025**. This intake is for children born between 1st September 2020 and 31st August 2021. Applications must be made by January 2025, so we have made several available dates when prospective parents can visit our school.

If you know of anyone who may be interested, please encourage them to get in touch to book a visit. If you already have a child in school and another due to start next year, you are still welcome to visit school of course!


