Our governing body play an incredibly vital role in the strategic management of our school both supporting and challenging our Leadership and direction of travel. September 2025! Important information:

A reminder for parents of children in **Year 6/Windsor class**. Year 6 parents should have received a letter explaining the application process for secondary school places. Over the next few weeks all local schools are holding their open day events for the Year 6 children to attend. We recommended that you should try to go and see as many schools as you can to help you make an informed choice. For your information our children move typically either to the Snaith School, Carlton Holy Family Catholic High School or Brayton Academy. **The deadline for Year 6 applications to be received is 31st October 2024.**

It is also that time of year when we already have to start thinking about our own **Reception intake for September 2024**. This intake is for children born between 1st September 2020 and 31st August 2021. Applications must be made by January 2025, so we have made several available dates when prospective parents can visit our school.

If you know of anyone who may be interested, please encourage them to get in touch to book a visit. If you already have a child in school and another due to start next year, you are still welcome to visit school of course!




And if you shop as ASDA:
